Purpose

To define the requirements for members who transfer into Maroochydore SLSC to have their Long Service Membership category recognised.

Definitions

Long Service Membership -

- (i) may be granted by a Club to members who have completed ten (10) years active service or to members who have completed eight (8) years active service plus four (4) years reserve active service:
- (ii) members shall be exempted from all patrol obligations and may be granted other special privileges of membership as provided in the Club Constitutions and By-Laws;
- (iii) should such members join another affiliated club the receiving club shall determine if such members Long Service shall be recognised by that club.

Policy

Members transferring into Maroochydore SLSC with a Long Service Membership category who wish to have the Club recognise that category would be required to complete:

- two (2) Voluntary Patrols [morning or afternoon]
- or one (1) full day Voluntary Patrol

prior to a date to be set by the Director of Surf Life Saving and Director of Administration and Membership.

Application

Members that wish to have Long Service Membership recognised are to make a written application to the Board of Management for consideration of their application.
