SUBJECT Dual Membership and Patrol Hours

APPROVED BY BOARD of MANAGEMENT

The following policy statement was adopted at the Board of Management meeting dated 26 October 2000 and adopted as Maroochydore Club policy from that date.

Dual Club Membership and Competition Patrol Hours

Surf Life Saving Queensland Patrol Hours and Competition Rights Policy details the requirements that all surf clubs must adhere to. At Section 'D' it states "that all active Senior, Junior, Cadet, Reserve, Award and Under 14 members who wish to contest 'Senior' Championships must carry out patrol duties for the club they wish to represent."

At Section 'F' it states "that the minimum number of personally completed hours must not be less than 25 hours for each calendar year, i.e., 1st January to 31st December of the same year." There is an exception in that new or transferring members are required to do four (4) hours patrol per month from the time of submitting a membership application form to the Club they wish to compete for.

Given the requirements of the policy that is currently in place it is clear that you must complete patrol hours for Maroochydore if you wish to compete for the Club.
