Some of the many supporting² roles that you, as a family member of a child involved in Junior Activities, can play include:

JUNIOR ACTIVITIES SUNDAY TRAINING

Water Safety

hold Surf Rescue Certificate (SRC) or Bronze Medallion (BM) Award.

Age Manager

hold Observer or SRC or BM Award; and do the online course & 2-3 assessments.

Gear Steward

No qualification needed, just a desire to be organised and organise others.

BBQ helper

No qualification needed. Though a love of mixing with people and making delicious food helps.

Committee Member

Be part of the dedicated team that works to improve Maroochydore's Junior Activities Programs.

EDUCATION AND TRAINING AWARDS

CPR

1/2 day of training and you can receive a Nationally Recognised Certificate accepted by sporting clubs and workplaces.

First Aid

1-day training and you are issued with a Nationally Recognised Certificate accepted by sporting clubs and workplaces.

Observers

2-3 hours of training and you're on your way to be an Age Manager or Radio Officer

Surf Rescue Certificate

Competency based training in basic lifesaving and first aid skills. Challenging but you'll make life-long friends.

Bronze Medallion

Competency based training aimed to make you patrol ready. The recognised entry point for volunteer Lifesavers.

IRB Crew

Looking for something more exciting, add to your Bronze Award and extend your ability to support Junior Activities training and Surf Sport events.

IRB Driver

Take your IRB skills to the next level and become a specialist driver in white-water conditions.

SURF SPORTS

Official

Combined on-line & F2F course completed in 12 months. 3 graded levels: - **CORE** – JA entry **TECHNICAL** – Starter, Check Starter, etc. **SENIOR** – Sectional & Carnival Referee

Coach

Aligned to the Australian Sports Commission, the SLSA Coaches course includes on-line theory, F2F induction and assessment. Must finish within 12 months.

Club Photographer

If you can take an awesome action photo and love sitting around at a surf carnival waiting for the 'shot' – then sign up. 2 Photographers endorsed each season.

Chaperone

Assist to ensure our JA members enjoy a safe and fun environment when travelling and representing the Club. Male and Female Chaperones are needed.

Team Manager

Working with the Age Managers, Coaches and Selectors your focus is to efficiently & effectively manage the Club's teams during the season. A desire to walk miles and good sense of humour essential.
